To provide emergency appropriations for continuing operations of the Merchant Marine Academy in the event of a funding gap.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 SECTION 1. EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR
 CONTINUING OPERATIONS OF THE UNITED
 STATES MERCHANT MARINE ACADEMY DUR ING FUNDING GAP.
 (a) APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR OPERATIONS.—

8 During a funding gap, the Secretary of the Treasury shall
9 make available to the Secretary of Transportation, out of
10 any amounts in the general fund of the Treasury not oth-

erwise appropriated, such amounts as the Secretary of
 Transportation determines to be necessary to continue to
 provide (without interruption) for the following:

4 (1) Continuing operations of the United States
5 Merchant Marine Academy during the funding gap.
6 (2) At the discretion of the Secretary of Trans7 portation, pay and allowances for such civilian per-

sonnel of the Merchant Marine Academy who are
providing support for the operations described in
paragraph (1) as the Secretary considers appropriate.

(3) At the discretion of the Secretary of Transportation, pay and allowances for such contractor
personnel at the Merchant Marine Academy who are
providing support for the operations described in
paragraph (1) as the Secretary considers appropriate.

(b) FUNDING GAP DEFINED.—In this section, the
term "funding gap" means any period of time after the
beginning of a fiscal year for which interim or full-year
appropriations for accounts for the operations of the
United States Merchant Marine Academy for that fiscal
year have not been enacted.
